Meeting Notes

- 1. Approval of previous minutes
 - Charlie Brown moved to approve the minutes from the previous meeting and John Kennedy seconded.
- 2. Business Arising from the previous minutes
 - AGC discussed the water trapped along the main highway, surrounding the trees. Approval
 for a new culvert has been received and will be installed by the end of the month. A trench
 may be installed if elevations are favourable or a pumping system will be installed to remove
 water.



- AGC followed up regarding the naming of the road and is waiting on the naming convention.
 It is a different jurisdiction and therefore a new application may be required. The road will be named Moose River West. AGC will install a temporary sign until approved.
- AGC submitted an application for streetlights to be installed from the bridge to the entrance
 of the mine site. An inspector will be sent to view the area and is scheduled to be on site
 this month.
- AGC followed-up on the status of the road. The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal responded that the asphalt will be removed and the gravel topped up for the full 19 kilometre distance by the end of August 2018. Paving will commence in 2019. Traffic lights and a gate will be installed on AGC property.

3. Presentation

- A guest speaker from Intrinsik Corp provided a presentation for the Committee "Federal Mining Regulations".
 - ACTION ITEM: The Committee would like a copy of the Federal Mining Regulations presentation
- The Committee discussed the stability of the dam on Scraggy Lake and the possibility of refurbishing due its current weakened condition.
 - ACTION ITEM: The CLC recommends the dam on Scraggy Lake should be refurbished submit consideration to Nova Scotia Environment (NSE) and the Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO)

4. Project Updates

a. Touquoy Gold Project:

The Committee was provided an update of the Touquoy mine site operations. An Environment update was also provided.

Approval has been received to remove some of the Historical tailings containing mercury. A cell is being constructed in the Tailings Management Facility (TMF) to dispose these tailings. Final approval is still required to remove the remainder of the Historical tails and delays in approval have resulted in higher water levels in the TMF. A coffer dam had to be constructed as the water level has risen.



b. Cochrane Hill and Fifteen Mile Stream update:

The Committee was provided an update of the Cochrane Hill and Fifteen Mile stream properties progress, including the corridor drilling program between Touquoy and Beaver Dam and Beaver Dam to Fifteen Mile Stream. A new CLC will be set up for each of these properties.

ACTION ITEM: Committee members interested in participating in the Fifteen Mile Stream CLC meetings can provide their names to AGC's Community Relations and Land Management Consultant.

c. Beaver Dam Update:

The Committee discussed current activities at Beaver Dam, including the current groundwater monitoring well program.

New Business

a. Recruitment of New Members:

The Committee was discussed methodology to recruit new members to fill the three current vacancies. The Committee can bring forward names and vote on new members. The Committee discussed possible committee membership names.

ACTION ITEM: The Committee will extend an invitation to recruit a new member. ACTION ITEM: AGC to provide the AGC newsletter to Committee Chairperson to circulate to members.

b. FOIPOP:

AGC received correspondence from the NSE FOIPOP committee regarding a public request to receive meeting minutes from the CLC as well as the names of the CLC members.

ACTION ITEM: Develop a consistent and concise format for meeting minutes, focusing on action items and CLC member concerns

ACTION ITEM: Summarized meeting minutes to be posted on the AGC website. This was approved and seconded by the Committee
